Whereupon the following business was transacted and is now placed of record in the minutes of said Court:

County Redistricting

Stan Reid with Allison Bass and Associates met with the court to evaluate demographics and redistricting of county political boundaries. Motion to Issue Order Redistricting Political Boundaries and set date for public hearing on November 8, 2021 was made by Charlie Morris, seconded by Jerry Alexander. Motion passed unanimously.

Reconsideration of In Trust Property Bid

Motion was made by Jerry Alexander to reconsider the Court's action of October 7, 2021 regarding the bid by Steve and Donna Drennan for the purchase of Lot 1, Block 139 of the Original Town of Dickens, and on further consideration of the matter, to accept the bid. The motion was seconded by Charlie Morris. Motion passed unanimously.

Discuss/Approve County Attorney to represent Dickens County in Litigation

Motion was made by Mike Smith, seconded by Dennis Wyatt to approve Aaron Clements, County Attorney to represent Dickens County in the National Opioid Litigation Settlement and adoption of the Texas Term Sheet. Motion passed unanimously.
