

MINUTES OF COMMISSIONER'S COURT

July 26, 2021

Be it remembered that on July 26, 2021 the Honorable Commissioners Court met in Special Session with these members present, to-wit: County Judge Kevin Brendle. Commissioners Dennis Wyatt, Precinct #1, Mike Smith, Precinct #2, Charlie Morris, Precinct #3, Jerry Alexander, Precinct #4. The meeting was called to order at 9:04 a.m. by County Judge, Kevin Brendle for the purpose of a budget workshop and a special agenda. Whereupon the following business was transacted and is now placed of record in the minutes of said Court:

**Receive Annual Report from VFD and others.**

Spur Volunteer Fire Department Chief Wess Abbott gave the annual report for the fire department.

**Budget Workshop**

Patti Abbott, Chief Appraiser reviewed the 2021 Certified Values with the Court. Mrs. Abbott pointed out the 2020 corrected values after the settlement with the McAdoo Wind Farm reflected a value of \$246,322,568.00. The current values are at \$240,876,190.00 which is a decrease of \$5,446,378.

A budget workshop was conducted to prepare a proposed budget to be filed with the clerk by July 30, 2021. The proposed budget will reflect a 3% salary increase for the County Treasurer, County Tax Assessor and deputy, County Clerk and deputy, Justice of the Peace and County Extension Agent office assistant. A Public Hearing on the Proposed Budget was set for Monday, August the 16, 2021 at 8:30am in the Courthouse Annex – Multi-Purpose Room.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mike Smith, seconded by Jerry Alexander. Motion passed unanimously.
