"BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT Dickens County" strongly opposes the proposed new rule to define "waters of the United States" in that it increases the need for burdensome and costly permitting requirements, infringes on private property rights, and circumvents the legislative process, thus, the will of the people."
