Be it remembered that on May 10, 2021 the Honorable Commissioners Court met in Regular Session with these members present, to-wit: County Judge Kevin Brendle. Commissioners, Dennis Wyatt, Precinct #1; Mike Smith, Precinct 2; Charlie Morris, Precinct #3; Jerry Alexander, Precinct #4, Becky Hill, County Clerk and Darla Thomason, Treasurer. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by County Judge, Kevin Brendle. The meeting opened with a prayer by Harry Bob Martin, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. Flag and the Texas Flag.
